



## WHAT IS THIS CLASS ALL ABOUT?

Vox is an auditioned ensemble open to students in grades 10-12 who are committed to achieving the highest levels of musical excellence. The group is geared towards treble (high) voices who show significant control over their vocal technique and have developed their musical literacy and musicianship skills. Through the study of challenging choral literature, students in Vox aspire to create meaningful musical performances for their listeners. Most importantly, it is a group of like-minded individuals who exist to support each other, and build a community of singing-artists. Vox meets everyday, for 5 credits; it is an honors ensemble.

## WHAT TYPE OF ASSIGNMENTS/ACTIVITIES CAN I EXPECT?

Like Concert Chorus, assessments in Vox are mainly informal, ungraded, performance based assessments. There are also periodic self-assessments and singing assessments submitted through Google Classroom. Additionally, Vox is the flagship vocal ensemble of Hanover High School, which means extracurricular commitments throughout the year -- we are often asked to sing at sporting and community events, and members are required to have a flexible schedule so that they may attend the majority of these events.
