### EDUCATORS MAY EARN PDPs FOR:

- \* Designing a Professional Development Activity That IS RELATED TO THE ACADEMIC DISCIPLINE OF THE **EDUCATOR'S LICENSE** 
  - Products may include: published written materials such as a journal article, book chapter, reference guide, or blog article.
  - The PD must be at least 10 hours per Topic AND have a final product that is shared with staff and/or administration

#### **\*** DEVELOPING AND IMPLEMENTING AN ACTIVITY FOR STUDENTS, PARENTS OR TEACHERS THAT INCORPORATES THE LEARNING STANDARDS OF THE CURRICULUM FRAMEWORKS.

Activities should include an assessment of learning related to the learning standards and curriculum frameworks.
