The district recently received notice that all but one of our proposed items on the **Corrective Action Plan for the CPR for Special Education and Civil Rights** were approved by DESE. (see enclosed form entitled, Progress Report Summary) This means that the corrective action plan we put in place to address the areas of noncompliance was acceptable, and if the criterion is also listed as corrected it means that the documentation and other evidence we submitted proved that we had obtained compliant status. If it lists no under Corrected, it means it is an area that I am still working on gathering data for DESE through the on-site file reviews I am presently conducting through January 9th.

For CR25, the state is asking us to conduct a more in-depth self-evaluation regarding access to programming and related concerns, which I am in the process of developing.

We also recently received a report from DESE regarding English Learner Education (see enclosed report). WE submitted a proposal for a Corrective Action Plan. Dese has responded with this report, approving 6 of our proposed actions for correction, and partially approving 5 proposed actions for correction. I will move forward by following all of the state's directives in each area.
