

The Office of Family & Community Engagement has concluded a very busy and successful year of programming across the district and throughout the community. We are just weeks away from beginning our 8th season of Summer Enrichment programming and are already planning for our fall sessions of Enrichment, Performing Arts, Vocal and Instrumental Lessons and Community Adult Education. We continue to see steady growth in these programs, both in variety and enrollment. Below is a two year comparison reflecting a 13% increase in enrollment:

We are eager to kick off the new fiscal year with a diverse and active summer schedule. We will be offering over 110 classes for students in Kindergarten - 12th grade including new creative, recreational and academic opportunities such as Photography, Coding and Baseball. We continue to accept registrations throughout the summer and anticipate we will serve over 1000 students during our 5 weeks of programming. This summer we will also begin to create a documentary of a year in the life of FACE. We look forward to sharing this endeavor with you in June of 2018.

In addition to our continued growth in programming and before and after school programs, we collaborated with the High School this year to streamline community service opportunities for high school students. We have made many improvements to the process including a Community Service page in Aspen accessible to students and families as well as enhancements to reporting capabilities. I am pleased to share that Hanover High School students have completed 9491 hours of service to date this fiscal year. FACE employee Erin Condon, Community Service Coordinator has been instrumental in streamlining the process as well as building partnerships with community organizations and businesses. Her efforts have transformed the Community Service graduation requirement. Together with Brian Converse, Database Administrator, we continue to develop improvements to the processes and accessibility of the program. His expertise along with Erin's organization and oversight continue to strengthen the program. We look forward to sharing a comprehensive report of our Community Service progress with you in the fall.

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
