

Hanover School Subcommittee for Review of Elementary School Configuration

The Hanover School Committee hereby establishes a subcommittee to review and report regarding possible elementary configurations for the Hanover Elementary Schools. The subcommittee is charged with:

1. examining the positive and negative aspects of town-wide elementary schools;
2. making recommendations for configuration, space requirements and educational needs for town-wide elementary schools;
3. examining the positive and negative aspects of neighborhood-wide elementary schools;
4. making recommendations for configuration, space requirements and educational needs for neighborhood elementary schools (specifically, any changes to improve our current structure);
5. examining the positive and negative aspects of adding 5th grade to our elementary schools;
6. making recommendations for configuration, space requirements and educational needs for adding 5th grade to our elementary schools;
7. examining the detriments to each configuration and offering potential solutions to address such detriments.

The subcommittee shall consist of the

- Principal of Center / Sylvester School (or her designee),
- the Principal of Cedar School (or her designee),
- the Principal of the Middle School (or his designee),
- Deborah St. Ives,
- 1 Cedar teacher,
- 1 Center teacher,
- 1 5th grade teacher,
- 3 community members and
- 1 Adjustment Counselor.
