Re: Student Activities Account Authorization – HHS Interact Club

This year, Hanover High School has been pleased to form the HHS Interact Club sponsored by the Tri-Town Rotary and led by Scott Hutchison. The club came together after the 2018-2019 Handbook was published and therefore was not listed. At the time of publication, we weren't sure if the club would be able to start this year, so the decision was made not to include it. Through generous funding from the Tri-Town Rotary, the club was able to form late this school year. In the spirit of their mission stated below, the club sponsored a car show on June 6, 2018 which raised \$449 for the Wounded Warrior Project. The HHS Interact Club will be added to the Program of Studies next year with the following description:

HHS Interact Club:

Interact clubs bring together young people ages 12-18 to develop leadership skills while discovering the power of Service Above Self. The goal of the Interact club is to organize at least two projects every year, one that helps the school or community and one that promotes international understanding. The primary benefit for our members is to connect with leaders in the community to take action to make a difference in the school and community and to become a leader in your school and community.

As the car show came together quickly this year, I gave the high school emergency authorization to add the Interact Club to the HHS Student Activities Account pending authorization from the School Committee.
