 - Identify areas for growth within each Building/Grade
 - Identify students for specific interventions
- Provides Parents (K-12) with an opportunity to report on concerns related to climate and proficiency of SEL Skills.
- By adding the question: "Do you have a child with a disability?" we will be able to approximately disaggregate the data between General Education and Special Education Students.




Student Self-Perception of SEL Competencies

How did students perceive their own social-emotional skills?






Topic Breakdown








