# Report on Teaching & Learning:

## HHS Program of Studies

- A Summary of Changes was presented for 2015-2016
- Some minor changes were made such as, dates and names.
- The new rubric criteria for HHS graduates to speak effectively was added
- *The Pearl* was deleted from English 9-1 and 9-2
- Addition of Anchor TV/Broadcast Journalism
- Looked at all social studies electives and extended them out to be full year courses
- Updated mathematics language to align to the Common Core expectations
- Other changes are editorial or grammatical
- Psychology/Sociology will also be a year-long elective
- Question by Mr. Geary- explain the difference between 2.5 credits versus 5 credits. Response by Mr. Paquette that some electives can be taken full year for 5 credits or every other day for 2.5 credits but all will be year long
- Comment by Ms. Lynch- great work creating such an outstanding document-Mission Statement is very clear, description of courses is excellent and what is expected of students is clear. I commend you and the School Council on this
- Mr. Paquette would like to recognize Dr. Raab on his hard work on this Program of Studies
- Motion by Geary to accept the HHS Program of Studies 2015-2016 as written with minor changes in the future. The motion was seconded by Phillips. The motion carried by a majority vote with an abstention by Lynch.

**Public Comment:** Comment by Mr. Geary that he had a meeting today with staff and Ann Logan of PTA regarding Vision 2020- made a 3 part plan over the next 8 weeks to have the community informed of the Vision 2020 plan.
