





In the beginning, there were three colors:




Reds.

Reds were the loudest.




Yellows were the brightest,



And something happened.




Yellow and Blue became inseparable.





But not all the colors were happy about it.




But Yellow and Blue loved each other so much, they decided to

Together, they created a new color.




They named her Green.

Green was bright like Yellow








The old neighborhoods of Redville, Blue Town, and Yellow Heights didn't make sense anymore. Everyone wanted to live together, so they rebuilt the city.

Draw a circle for the body.




Step 2:
Draw a line and a circle for the legs and feet.





Draw lines for the arms and the fingers. Use a circle for the finger tips!





Draw the eyes and nose using circles and dots.




