## What can I expect from Public Speaking?

Students will create and present various styles of public speeches, focusing on rehearsal, expression, engagement, memorization techniques and more. The goal for each student is to learn the process of speaking, from forming of topics to final presentation, and to gain the confidence and skill set to create and deliver coherent, engaging speeches.

## Scheduling & Credits

Public Speaking is an every-other-day elective course for 2.5 credits. Depending on the year, Public Speaking may be a part of a Freshman based seminar known as Freshmen Communications.
