## **Building Condition**

50 year old building

## Exterior:

deteriorating single-pane, non-thermal metal window system cracked glass block

rotting wood doors

deteriorating masonry (needs control joints, repointing, replacement)

spalling concrete

moisture damage behind masonry due to no vapor barrier

poor roofing conditions: ponding, holes, gaps create roof leaks; non-existent or damaged roof edge structural upgrades required to meet today's seismic codes

#### Interior:

vinyl asbestos tile flooring needs to be abated and replaced

aged carpeting with duct tape used at seams

gymnasium flooring at the end of its useful life

aged stage wood floor

deteriorating wood window sills

cracks in concrete block walls

aged operable walls have poor acoustic quality

damaged wood doors without accessible clearances

door hardware does not meet accessibility requirements

deteriorating kitchen equipment

ceiling tiles containing asbestos need to be abated and replaced

non-code-compliant plumbing fixtures (both in accessibility and water usage)

aged toilet partitions and accessories

non-code-compliant stair handrails and guardrails

lack of interior signage required by code (exit signs, room signs, etc.)

non-code-compliant lockers

non-code-compliant bleachers

non-code-compliant auditorium layout

non-code-compliant toilet rooms

antiquated electrical wiring and technology systems

antiquated heating, cooling and ventilation systems

## Health & Safety

poor indoor air quality

asbestos- and lead-containing materials

corridor and stairwell doors and walls are not smoke or fire-rated

egress doors do not have required hardware

## Educational Needs—On-going Accreditation Issues

8 of the 9 Science Labs have original, antiquated, and in poor condition casework

Science Labs lack electrical, data, gas and water connections required to teach the subject

Technology Education Lab (woodshop) equipment is original, antiquated and in poor condition

all general classrooms have only two electrical outlets

the media center size is below minimum state guidelines

student council now occupies a former toilet room

nurse's area offers no privacy

guidance rooms have poor acoustic quality and offer no privacy

no space for Choral program or for music practice rooms

current Music Technology Lab is in two former storage rooms
