Budgeting and Planning Updates

- State aid (Chapter 70): -10% = -\$702,388 (presently accounted for in proposed budget via \$228,836 in cuts plus \$473,552 in free cash recommended by AdComm)
- Circuit Breaker reimbursement funds (CB): 30-40% = -\$170,000
- State and federal grants: -\$50,000-\$75,000
- School reopening plans are forthcoming in the near future: <u>these will be adaptable</u> <u>throughout the summer:</u>
 - In person/hybrid/combination
 - PPE Requirements
 - Social Distancing
 - Transportation
 - Contact Tracing
 - Lunch, specialists, recess, sports, etc.

Personnel Update

- *Round one* of staff recalls completed on June 19th:
 - 20 teachers
 - 6 support staff (administrative assistants and paraprofessionals)
- *Round two* of recalls on June 23rd:
 - 12 teachers (art, music, PE, tech = fully restored)
 - 8 support staff (paraprofessionals = fully restored)
- We continue to evaluate FY '21 needs before any long-term substitute positions are approved for return
