## Key Changes 2020/2021

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- Page 20: All Freshmen will be required to take the PSAT 8/9 beginning March 2020. On March 25th, we are holding a standardized testing day for nearly all students. Freshmen will be taking the PSAT 8/9, sophomores will take ELA MCAS, juniors will take a practice AP exam or SAT, and seniors will take a practice AP exam or conclude Humanities field study hours.
