Program Description

The SAT Bootcamp at HHS was offered from January 6 through March 11, 2020. A total of forty-nine sessions were available on 25 school days -- Monday, Wednesday, and Thursday -- both before and after school. A total of 67 students participated. Sessions were monitored by faculty members. Students used the Khan Academy SAT preparation program. The program provides practice SAT problems. After answering the questions, students can read detailed explanations. In addition, to support the students that had questions, we created an email address sathelp@hanoverschools.org so that students could screenshot a particular question and have their teacher (or curriculum director) provide support in person or through email.



- Average number of hours spent practicing: 11


Session Attendance by Student (number of sessions attended varied from 1 to 25)
