



 - Focus on efficacy of identification and interventions for at risk students
- Teaching and Learning Alliance (TLA)
 - Nonprofit organization of master teachers (K-12) who provide in school coaching and professional development
 - Reviewed/observed current reading assessments and instructional practices and offered recommendations for improvement in Tier 1



Our Approach

Guiding Question - "Does this fit what we know about Hanover?"

- Read, reviewed, and synthesized findings
 - Dr. King & TLA Reports
- Created a matrix to organize initial findings
- Determined commonalities
- Solidified findings by researching the results
- Analyzed current literacy practices
- Prioritized immediate areas of action
