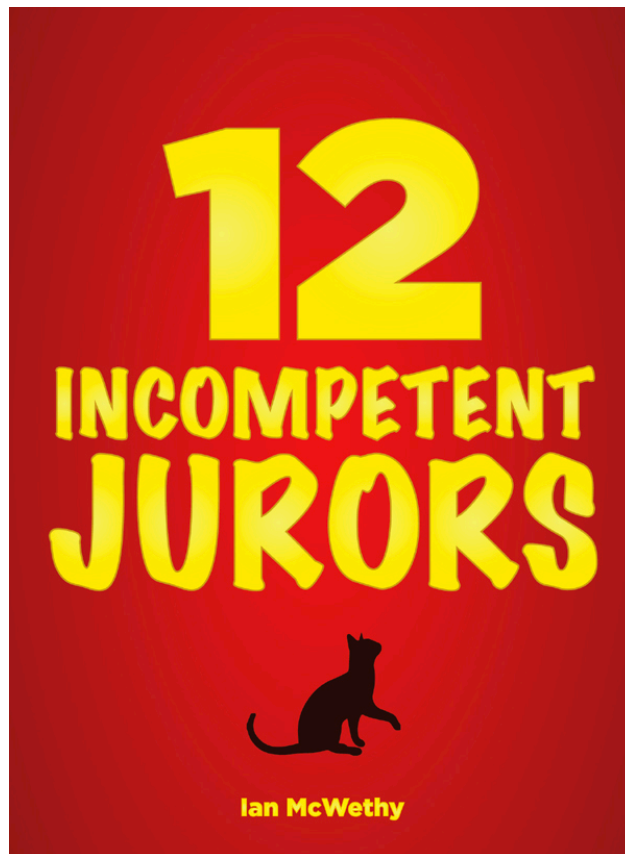


The Hanover Performing Arts Company is pleased to offer our first Community Theater production!
