PARADE ROUTE AND EXPECTATIONS

Seniors participating/driving in the parade should meet at the high school for 6:00 pm. Upon arriving at the high school, proceed down Cedar Drive and follow all traffic-control directives from the Hanover Police Department to arrange for parade.

- Students must remain in their cars.
- Parade leaves the high school at 6:30 pm.

As the parade begins, you will travel the following **ROUTE:**

- Turn right onto **CEDAR STREET**
- Left onto PLEASANT STREET
- Cross over Rt.139 to CIRCUIT STREET
- Right onto **MYRTLE STREET**
- Cross CENTER STREET TO CROSS STREET
- Left onto BROADWAY
- Cross COLUMBIA RD
- Left onto WASHINGTON STREET
- Left onto ROCKLAND STREET
- Right onto RT. 53 NORTH
- Left onto OLD WASHINGTON STREET
- Left onto **SILVER STREET**
- Left into CENTER SCHOOL REAR LOT
- Right onto **HANOVER STREET**
- Right onto PLEASANT STREET
- Right onto **WEBSTER STREET**
- Right onto MAIN STREET
- Right onto CEDAR STREET
- Right into CEDAR DRIVE
- Proceed through CEDAR parking lot & into HIGH SCHOOL parking lot

EXPECTATIONS

- Students cannot ride with other Students.
- All students can either ride solo, or they can ride with immediate family members. We encourage all students to ride with immediate family members.
- Number of people in the motor vehicle shall NOT exceed the number of seatbelts in the motor vehicle.
- No riding in the beds of pick-up trucks.
- No riding on roofs.
- No hanging out windows or moonroofs.
- No throwing items from motor vehicle.
