

# Town-Wide Car Parade

### **PARADE ROUTE AND EXPECTATIONS**

Seniors participating/driving in the parade should meet at the high school for 6:00 pm. Upon arriving at the high school, proceed down Cedar Drive and follow all traffic-control directives from the Hanover Police Department to arrange for parade.

- Students must remain in their cars.
- Parade leaves the high school at 6:30 pm.

As the parade begins, you will travel the following **ROUTE**:

- Turn right onto **CEDAR STREET**
- Left onto **PLEASANT STREET**
- Cross over Rt.139 to **CIRCUIT STREET**
- Right onto **MYRTLE STREET**
- Cross **CENTER STREET TO CROSS STREET**
- Left onto **BROADWAY**
- Cross **COLUMBIA RD**
- Left onto **WASHINGTON STREET**
- Left onto **ROCKLAND STREET**
- Right onto **RT. 53 NORTH**
- Left onto **OLD WASHINGTON STREET**
- Left onto **SILVER STREET**
- Left into **CENTER SCHOOL REAR LOT**
- Right onto **HANOVER STREET**
- Right onto **PLEASANT STREET**
- Right onto **WEBSTER STREET**
- Right onto **MAIN STREET**
- Right onto **CEDAR STREET**
- Right into **CEDAR DRIVE**
- Proceed through CEDAR parking lot & into HIGH SCHOOL parking lot

## EXPECTATIONS

- Students cannot ride with other Students.
- All students can either ride solo, or they can ride with immediate family members. *We encourage all students to ride with immediate family members.*
- Number of people in the motor vehicle shall NOT exceed the number of seatbelts in the motor vehicle.
- No riding in the beds of pick-up trucks.
- No riding on roofs.
- No hanging out windows or moonroofs.
- No throwing items from motor vehicle.

\* Failure to adhere to the above expectations will result in you being removed from the parade route.
