Kindergarten and first grade students have been busy in the art room learning about the elements and principals of art. We have been exploring many different mediums and learning about different artists. Each student will have two works of art on display.

KINDERGARTEN WORKS OF ART

Georgia O'Keeffe Inspired Flower

(oil pastel, tempera paint cakes)

What better way to learn about American modernist artist Georgia O'Keeffe than to paint giant flowers like she did! Students also practiced their color mixing skills. We painted with the primary colors and students created secondary colors by mixing the primary colors.

Color Mixing Things!

(tempera paint, black sharpie)

We watched a fun video about primary and secondary colors! Students painted circles with primary colors on their paper. They then mixed primary colors together to create secondary colors. Using the secondary colors, they painted additional circles on the same piece of paper. Lastly, the students used black sharpie to turn their circles into creative color mixing things!

Matisse Inspired Collage

(construction paper, scissors, glue stick)

What fun we had learning about French artist Henri Matisse and his love for creating collages using scissors as his paintbrush! Students created amazing compositions of color.

Kandinsky Inspired Circles

(white glue, q-tip, chalk pastel)

Russian painter Wassily Kandinsky used music to evoke feelings of color to create colorful paintings. We learned about abstract art. Students painted with white glue on black paper combined with chalk pastels. What amazing Kandinsky inspired circles they created.

Perspective Snowman

(oil pastel, white tempera paint)

Learning about perspective in art could not have been more interesting than creating giant snowmen using oil pastels! After the snow creations were accessorized, students got to experiment with splatter painting to add snow.

Tints and Shades Silly Pig!

(oil pastel, crayon, tempera paint)

Oh, what fun students had learning about tints and shades! It was so much fun watching them create their silly pigs and then bring them to life with paint!

FIRST GRADE WORKS OF ART

Mixed Media Owl

(oil pastel, crayon, tempera paint)

A mixed media creation based on texture and collage. We watch to a fun video to learn about texture in art. Students had fun creating their owl masterpieces.

Tissue Paper Winter Landscape

(construction paper, tissue paper, white glue, tempera paint, black sharpie)

Students enjoyed using tissue paper as a painting tool. The creation of these winter landscapes was fun but adding the splatter painted snow might have been the best part to watch.

Mondrian Inspired Collage

(black paper strips, oil pastel, crayon)

Students enjoyed learning about Dutch painter Piet Mondrian. Using only the primary colors, black and white students created Mondrian inspired collages!

Starry Night Inspired by Vincent van Gogh

(oil pastel)

What fun learning about Dutch painter Vincent van Gogh. After studying the famous painting, The Starry Night, students were able to create their own version of this masterpiece.

Jim Dine Inspired Painted Hearts

(oil pastel, tempera paint)

American artist Jim Dine and his heart artwork was the inspiration for these beautiful and colorful hearts. Students learned to add paint to only one side of their paper and then 'printed it' to the other side!
