

10 Ways to Get Your Child Ready for K

- 1. Play outside.
- 2. Limit screen time.
- 3. Teach your child to WAIT.
- 4. Early, consistent bedtimes (myth daycare vs. full day K same)
- 5. Provide opportunities for children to be bored.
- 6. Encourage independent problem solving with peer and sibling conflicts.
- 7. Play board and card games. Let them lose.
- 8. Keep schedules at a minimum in the fall. Kinders are tired. It takes at least 8 weeks to adjust.
- 9. Encourage overall independence with coats, bags, mealtimes, shoes, backpacks, lunchboxes.
- 10. Teach respect for adults, materials, and peers. Discourage Interrupting.
