Course registration will be completed online through the student portal in X2 ASPEN

Please note: Course registration needs to be completed in the individual student account. Course registration is not available through the parent portal.

The courses you have been recommended for have already been pre-populated.

Logging on Through Individual Student Account

- 1. After logging in, click the tab "My Info."
- 2. On the side column, click "Requests."
- 3. Click the "Select" button next to the subject to choose an elective and/or make a change to the recommended course.
- 4. Check the box next to the courses.
- 5. If you would like to leave a note for a guidance counselor, type in your message under "Notes for Counselor."
- 6. Once completed with all selections, click "post" at the bottom of the page.

Guidance counselors will review the student selections after the portal is closed.

If a student has requested a higher level course than what has been recommended, the request will be reviewed by the Hanover High School administration team.

If the request is denied, a letter will be sent to families indicating the student will be placed in the level that was recommended by the teacher. If approved, the student will be placed in the requested course.

Once the portal is closed, students and parents will no longer have access to online registration.
