

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Snack/Lunch/Recess

- A snack should be packed each day.
- Hot/Cold Lunch is available each day.
- Lunch will be free for all students next year.
- Students will go outside for recess as often as possible. We consistently follow the child care weather watch guidelines.









- 1. Encourage playing outside.
- 2. Aim to limit screen time (phone/television)
- 3. Maintain early and consistent bedtimes.
- 4. Encourage independent problem solving with peer and sibling conflicts.
- 5. Try to keep schedules at a minimum in the fall, including after-school activities. The school days are long for Kindergarten students at the start of the year. It typically takes at least 8 weeks for students to adjust to this new schedule.
- 6. Encourage overall independence with coats, bags, mealtimes, shoes, and backpacks.
- 7. Teach showing respect to adults, peers, and materials.
