## **Visioning Committee Process**

- August 2021 Mr. Ferron selected Russ Wilson, Ellen McLaughlin and Terry Langton to chair the committee
- October 2022 Assembled a team from across HPS sectors to serve on the committee
- Nov Jan 21/22 Reviewed neighboring and DART district Vision Statements. Drafted a survey to help capture the essence of an HPS education from HPS constituencies
- February 2022 Surveyed the HPS community
- March/April Analyzed the results of the 757 responses that were submitted (50+ pages of individually spaced narratives!)
- April/May 2022 Drafted a Vision/Mission Statement & Motto to present to Mr. Ferron and the School Committee for vote



## A VISION describes an outcome, an end, and a future status of an organization.

A MISSION statement describes what an organization will do today to achieve the vision - for example, how will we equip students with the skills, understanding, and attitudes they will need to succeed?

### A mission and a vision statement are interdependent.



A MOTTO is a brief statement that encapsulates the core beliefs, guiding principles, and or major ideals of an organization.

## Vision Statement Survey Results 757 responses

- 206 Residents (27%)
- 118 Employees (16%)
- 488 Students (64%)
- 143 Parents (19%)

\* Question #8 was an open response question and we received upwards of 50 pages of single spaced, very thoughtful essay-type responses.

## **Q8 What is your vision?** Major Themes:

- Prepared for post-high school life
- Possesses skills and attitudes that support and enable continued learning (flexibility, communication, creativity, curious, hardworking)
- Well-rounded curriculum,
- Welcoming and challenging PK-12 environment for learning,
- High expectations for teaching and learning
